The Ascension of the Lord (Year B)

12th May 2024

Readings: Acts 1:1-11 Ephesians 1:17-23 Mark 16:15-20

The Ascension of our Lord

Last Sunday "After the Lord Jesus had talked with them, he was taken up to heaven and sat at the right side of God. The disciples went and preached everywhere, and the Lord worked with them and proved that their preaching was true by the miracles that were performed." (Mk 16:19-20).

In the ascension the human Jesus went to heaven, thus uniting heaven and earth. This is why the fact of a bodily ascension is important, because in a sense it completed the incarnation. It shows that Jesus really had overcome death - he wasn't resurrected to die again, but to live forever. For Christians, the fact that Jesus' followers witnessed him ascending into the clouds leaves no doubt that he is alive with the Father in Heaven and is no longer limited to living on Earth.

With the Ascension of Jesus something had been fundamentally changed for His followers, their understanding of death. Jesus had left them once before in His crucifixion and death on the Cross. But their devastation had been turned to joy in their experiences with Him for forty days after His resurrection. That turned their view of reality inside out. Life, for them, was to be seen in a radical new way and so was death. The Ascension was not an ending, it was a beginning. It was the beginning of our experience of God's presence to us in His risen Christ's newly formed body, His Mystical Body. At the same time the Ascension *is* God's promise to us that he will never leave us. God the Son's mission to us had been successfully accomplished. Now He will always be with us; He is as near to us now as our next Holy Communion. He is nearer to us now than if He were physically present as an individual somewhere in the world.

St. Paul says "for I am certain of this: nothing still to come, not any power, or height or depth, not any created thing, can ever come between us and the love of God that comes to us in Christ Jesus our Lord". The terrible ending of love relationships that comes to us not by choice but by death has been eradicated. It can never totally tear us away from each other. Those we love are not taken away from us forever. In the history of our salvation when Christ ascended into heaven the ministry of the Holy Spirit came into focus. The next coming of Christ will be at the end of the world. Each tick of the clock now takes us closer to that climactic moment. WE live now in the end game, in the End Time, awaiting that final victory when the ascended Christ will return for us.

Many Church documents keep reminding us of the basic mission entrusted to us by Jesus especially on the Feast of the Ascension. And the Second Vatican Council says, "Now the laity are called in a special way to make the Church present and operative in those places and circumstances where only through them can it become the salt of the earth" and "even when preoccupied with temporal cares, the laity can and must perform a work of great value for the evangelization of the world." (LG 33 & 35).
