Eleventh Sunday in Ordinary Time (Year B)

16th June 2024

Readings: Ezekiel 17: 22-24 2 Corinthians 5:6-10 Mark 4:26-34

"Be big in little things"

Saint Francis Xavier said, "Be big in little things." This was very much the spirituality of Saint Therese of Lisieux, her 'little way' as she referred to it. She died very young and did her tasks with an extraordinary love for the Lord. There are many saints in the Church who became great by doing little things.

The kingdom of God was present when Jesus healed the sick, forgave sinners, shared a table with the excluded, proclaimed the good news of God's unconditional love for all, gathered a new kind of community about himself that would later become the church. Jesus intended that the kingdom of God would continue to come into our world through the community of believers.

Today's scripture readings remind us that small is not only beautiful, but it is God's chosen way of manifesting his power and establishing his reign on earth. In the first reading prophet Ezekiel employs the metaphor of a small shoot becoming a mighty cedar tree to encourage his disheartened fellow Israelites and keep their hopes alive. He assures them that God has not abandoned them, that he will bring them back to their own land and make them great again.

We live in a time of unforeseen decline for the Church, both in the practice of the faith and its influence on society, a time of general mistrust of all things religious. But if God's Kingdom is like a mustard seed, then the size of our institutional church is not important. What matters is the quality of our witness. This is the good seed which, in God's time and God's way, will yield miraculous results. And let us continue to nurture the seed we have received. St. John of the Cross says, "At the evening of life, we shall be judged on our love."

We are indeed fortunate that we have such a rich word of God available to us in simple language with the rich imagery of sheep, birds, of the air, prodigal son, vineyard, and so on. We have the service of Jesus towards the poor, the blind, the lame, the deaf, the dumb, widows and other marginalized people. It is by trying to absorb God's word into our lives and by providing good soil and water on our side that we will be able to let the Kingdom take shape. The kingdom of God may begin to take root and be a tree in our life where the birds of the air can come and find shelter.

We know that, everywhere Jesus went, the crowd thronged around Him and often reached certain shores before Him. They were hungry for God's word. Many would have undoubtedly profited from those words but, in the lives of many others, those words must have been like seeds fallen on hard rock or among thorns, which prevented them from taking roots. While listening to God's word, let Jesus not have the occasion to say about us, "Their hearts have gone dull, and their ears are hard of hearing." We are indeed lucky for, as Jesus said, "Truly I say to you, many prophets and righteous men desired to see what you see and did not see it, and to hear what you hear and did not hear it."



FAITH MATTERS: The Parable of the Good Father ... he ran to his son - Luke 15:20

Excerpted from: 'Meditations' Luke 15:11-32. September 2021. The Word Among Us. Frederick, Maryland.

What an image! You can picture the Pharisees gasping at Jesus' description of a respected, wealthy landowner, advanced in age, hiking up his robes and running to greet his wayward son! Scandalous!

In the patriarchal culture of ancient Israel, any father acting as the father in the parable, would have brought scandal to himself and his family. The child should be the one coming to the father humble and repentant while the father stands firm.

The Pharisees were scandalised by Jesus' practice of openly 'welcoming sinners'. It is as if Jesus were saying - 'You think I am a cause for scandal? Let me tell you a parable about my heavenly Father and the depths of his mercy!

Whoever heard of a God who runs to welcome sinners before they have a chance to repent; who forgives sins we think are unforgiveable; who rejoices over us when we give very little reason to rejoice?

But this is your God. And God's unfathomable love is for you. In a world of pride and selfishness, a world that urges retaliation for every single slight, this idea of love is downright scandalous.

Your heavenly Father loves you completely. There's nothing you can do to make God give up on you. Eternal love, compassion and forgiveness.

So let God love you today. Let God embrace you and shower you with mercy. Let that mercy fill your heart and flow out to the people around you. 'Father thank you for your wondrous, scandalous love.' Luke 15: 11-32




