# **Progress Report**

Philosopher Socrates once said, "An unreflected life is not worth living." Last Sunday Jesus sent his apostles in pairs to a mission of preaching, curing and feeding. This Sunday the apostles returned and reported to Jesus what they had accomplished. The apostles must be very tired. And so, Jesus invited them to come away with him and rest. They were hoping to rest; to share the stories of their experiences but the crowd followed them. By seeing the crowd, he had compassion for them because "they were like sheep without a shepherd." And Jesus attended to their needs.

Luke says that "the seventy-two returned with joy and said, Lord, even the demons submit to us in your name." However, Jesus said, "do not rejoice that the spirits submit to you but rejoice that your names are written in heaven."

The report cards of students from the school or the report cards of the patients by the doctor or the report cards of the workers to the employer speak the same thing. Reflections and modifications are necessary elements to make any activity better. Jesus recognized the need to rest, and he is a compassionate God. Jesus placed the needs of the crowd above his own and he took pity on them, and he set himself to teach them. We are often caught with having to choose between our own legitimate needs and the needs of others. The choice is a hard one. Jesus' response however shows us how one that truly loves his neighbour behaves. Matthew says "come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For my yoke is easy and my burden is light." When we are feeling a little weary amidst the business of life, or probably we are burnout, we should have in mind that even our Lord recognized the need to rest and to pray not only for himself but also for the disciples.

"As Jesus went ashore, he saw a great crowd, and he had compassion for them, for they were like sheep without a shepherd." In our most trying moments, remember that we have a compassionate Lord. We only must trust in his great love who invites us to come to him. The Church's pastoral ministry is simply an extension of this pastoral compassion of Jesus our Lord. God says to his people, "I will appoint shepherds for them who will shepherd them." We need to pray that all those called to be shepherds in the Catholic Church are called by God. We also need to pray for both church and secular leaders who are serving us to follow God's will. Psalm 23 says, "The Lord is my shepherd, there is nothing I shall want."

Today, He was moved with pity for the people for their lack of leaders to lead them properly. Let us pray that we allow God to be our shepherd, that He guides us and feeds us with his Word and the Eucharist. They wanted direction in their lives. They wanted someone to tell them what is right and wrong so Jesus "began to teach and guide them."

### **FAITH MATTERS: Saint Mary Magdalene**

A faithful disciple of Christ, Mary ministered to his needs after having seven devils cast out from her. (Luke 8:2)

Mary witnessed his crucifixion (John 19:25), was present at his burial (Mark 15:47), and was the first to see the risen Lord at which time Mary was commissioned by Christ to proclaim the good news of his resurrection to the apostles (John 20:1-2, 11-18): "It was very early on the first day of the week and still dark, when Mary of Magdala came to the tomb. She saw that the stone had been moved away from the tomb and came running to Simon Peter and the other disciple, the one Jesus loved. 'They have taken the Lord out of the tomb" she said "and we don't know where they have put him.'

Mary stayed outside near the tomb, weeping. Then, still weeping, she stooped to look inside, and saw two angels in white sitting where the body of Jesus had been, one at the head, the other at the feet. They said, 'Woman, why are you weeping?' 'They have taken my Lord away' she replied 'and I don't know where they have put him.' As she said this she turned round and saw Jesus standing there, though she did not recognise him. Jesus said, 'Woman why are you weeping? Who are you looking for?' Supposing him to be the gardener, she said, 'Sir, if you have taken him away, tell me where you have put him, and I will go and remove him.' Jesus said, 'Mary!' She knew him then and said to him in Hebrew, 'Rabbuni!' - which means Master. Jesus said to her, 'Do not cling to me, because I have not yet ascended to my Father. But go and find the brothers and tell them: I am ascending to my Father and your Father, to my God and your God.' So Mary of Magdala went and told the disciples that she had seen the Lord and that he had said these things to her. "

St Mary Magdalene is remembered in the East as the "Apostle to the Apostles."


