The Most Holy Trinity (Year B) 26th May 2024

Readings: Deuteronomy 4:32-34,39-40 Romans 8:14-17 Matthew 28:16-20

Each year as we come to Trinity Sunday, we may wish we had the right tools to unravel the mystery of the triune God. As we make the circuit of each liturgical year, we must admit we do not have any greater understanding of the Trinity than we did last year. However, we pray for a deeper appreciation and love for the mystery that is God: Creator, Redeemer, Sanctifier. Trinity is a mystery. It is not only Trinity that is a mystery; in fact, but nothing about God can also adequately be explained. However, in the light of all that Jesus has revealed about, we are able to have a glimpse into the mystery of the Trinity, and try to explain it in some way, however imperfect that may be.

Jesus tells his disciples "Go therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit." Bible mentions in other places too about the three Persons of the Trinity with their distinct functions: God the Father as the Creator, God the Son as the Redeemer, and God the Holy Spirit as the Sanctifier. The difficulty of course arises when the Church teaches that while there are three distinct Persons in God there is only One Godhead having one Divine Nature.

The lesson that we learn from this Oneness is of the perfect unity in equality among the three Persons, despite having three different roles in our salvation. What it ultimately tells us for our day-to-day life is the importance of having a sense of common mission performed in unity with the people who are working along with us, as entrusted to us by Jesus and in which we are assisted by the Father and the Holy Spirit.

Jesus said, "You will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, throughout Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth." Yes, just being true witnesses is by itself a great mission. Pope St Paul VI emphasized the role of witnesses in his famous encyclical, *Evangelii Nuntiandi*. He wrote, "Modern man listens more willingly to witnesses than to teachers, and if he does listen to teachers, it is because they are witnesses."


What we need to know about this mystery is that Christian God is communitarian and primarily relational. This is what we need to bring into our lives from trinity – our relationship with the community. And now, before I start trying to explain the Trinity, let us conclude together with the Trinitarian action that has become the trademark of our faith: the sign of the cross: In the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

The mystery of the Most Holy Trinity is the central mystery of the Christian faith and of Christian life. God alone can make it known to us by revealing Himself as Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. The Incarnation of God's Son reveals that God is the eternal Father and that the Son is consubstantial with the Father, which means that, in the Father, which means that in the Father and with the Father the Son is one and the same God.

FAITH MATTERS: The Great Commission

Our Gospel this week contains what Christians have come to know as The Great Commission. It contains both a command and a promise.

The command from Jesus is that we followers (disciples) of Christ are charged to go out to make disciples of all nations and to baptise them in the name of the Trinity and to educate them in the observance of all the commandments of Jesus.

Christian Communities have taken this seriously for more than 2000 years to build up Christ's Body on earth. As Christians, today we are no less commanded to work within our broken secular communities to carry out the Great Commission but using the life and witness of Jesus and his love as our example.

Jesus' promise is that He will be with us always right to the end of time. We can rely on his strength, encouragement and inspiration to empower us to carry out the Great Commission and to fill our Churches with new disciples.

We pray: Lord give us the courage and the tenacity to be true disciples of yours, building up your Body the Church through education, baptism in the name of the Trinity, and loving encouragement in the name of Jesus wherever we may go.
